- Indian company's name and address
- Company <u>nameplate</u> and issuer's <u>signature</u>

(3) Travel Order (Original) (issued by Korean company)

Including below

- Issuing company's letterhead (company name, address, contacts/ email must be addressed)
- Issued date (Issued within 2 weeks of submitting the application date)
- Applicant's full name (same as on passport)
- Passport number and issued/expired date
- Visiting purpose and duration (*Important mentioned your detailed visiting plan)
 - Ex. 2023. 1. 20 ~ 2023. 2.1 / 2023. 3. 10 ~ 2023. 3. 24
- Indian company's name and address
- Company <u>nameplate</u>, Incorporate <u>stamp seal</u>, Issuer's <u>signature</u>

□ If you are a Positions of Director or C level or above the position (CEO, COO, etc.)

- Minimum USD10,000 of Bank guarantee or statement (in English, issued within 1 week of your submitting)

□ If you have valid India visa

- Your valid India visa (copy)

Note: In the case of Business Visa, you should upload all necessary documents such as Invitation, Travel order, Indian company's registration certificate, copy of passport and ID card. (Staying period in the letter should not exceed more than 180 days per entry)
